Ophthalmology

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Vitreo-Retinal Seminar July 16

This seminar is designed for Nurses keen to improve their knowledge and understanding of retinal disease and disorders.

The seminar will have a strong emphasis on current evidence based practice and clinical reasoning in treatment planning.

Eye Emergency Management March 6, September 18, December 11

Eye Emergency Management provides an interactive and practice based learning opportunity for nurses and other health professionals to develop their understanding and skills in triage, first line management, diagnostics, and discharge planning of the emergency eye patient.

Fundamental Aspects of Ophthalmic Nursing March 9 – 11 August 17 – 19

This 3 day course is aimed at nurses (RN,EN) who are interested in acquiring, and/or updating their knowledge and skills in ophthalmology.

The seminar will comprise of lectures, scenario based learning and practical demonstrations. A diagnostic workshop will be included.

Ophthalmic Infection Prevention and Control April 13

This seminar aims to develop nurses and other health professionals knowledge and practice of Infection Prevention and Control principles, including all aspects of CSSD processes related to ophthalmic practice.

Ophthalmic Skills June 20

Utilising various ophthalmic skills stations, participants will have the opportunity to acquire an understanding of ophthalmic procedures and practice hands on clinical skills to aid in the assessment of Eye conditions.

The skills stations comprise of mini-interactive lectures and practical workshops conducted by multidisciplinary ophthalmic clinicians.

Ophthalmology through the Life Span July 17

This seminar is designed for nurses (EN,RN) involved in the care of paediatric and /or geriatric ophthalmic patient. In this one day seminar we consider how the structure and function of the eye changes throughout the lifespan. Sessions include diagnosis and treatment of common childhood and age related conditions.

Perioperative Eye Course September 7 – 9

A three day practice based seminar aimed at peri-operative nurses and other health professionals who are interested in developing and/or updating their knowledge and practice in ophthalmic surgery.

Hand Courses

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Hand Trauma Seminar February 21

This Seminar aims to teach the essentials of hand trauma assessment and management from the perspective of Emergency Department staff, Medical Practitioners, Nurses and Therapists.

Hand Wound Management August 28

This seminar is designed for Nurses, Physiotherapists and Occupational Therapists who are interested in improving their knowledge, skills and their application in hand wound management.

The seminar will have a strong emphasis on current evidence based practice and clinical reasoning in treatment planning.

Hand Nursing Management November 12 – 13

This seminar is designed for Registered Nurses (ward based and new to operating theatres) who are interested in improving their knowledge, skills acquisition and application of these in the management of patients with hand injuries and conditions.
